
LONG THANH NORTH REUNION, 2016

Hello from Kansas City!! Which side to hold the reunion is not yet settled, and the organizational work to make it happen mainly depends upon how many will attend and what facility would best match the expected numbers.

Barbara and I are excited to host the 2016 Long Thanh North Reunion scheduled for:

29-30 September and 1 October 2016.

We have lots of great things to see and do, plus we have the greatest BBQ on the planet! Please help us by making your intentions known.

HERE IS WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU:

In order to negotiate the lowest hotel rates, we require a preliminary estimate on total nights needed—if you plan to attend the reunion and how many nights you plan to stay. This is not binding, and when we have enough information to finalize arrangements we will ask you to contact the hotel directly to make your individual reservations. Everyone in our group is eligible for the military/group rate. We know that some of you have family in town or may have already made housing arrangements.

Michael did preliminary work on a potential tour of the *Fort Leavenworth Command and General Staff College*. This was a topic of discussion in Tucson and many said they were interested. Due to security policies, the College requested that we consolidate vehicles. They will not allow access to the installation in multiple cars. Therefore, we plan to contract for a suitable mode of transportation (bus, van, etc.). Additionally, military veterans included in this tour require a background check. We don't want anyone to provide "name, rank and serial numbers" via the internet so we will find out exactly what information is required prior to the tour and then ask you to send that through the U.S. mail. We were informed there is a maximum number allowed within the group, so we first open this up to veterans and will also include spouses if room permits. Expect additional information as it becomes available.

Kansas City International Airport is approximately 35 miles from the city and a taxi costs approximately \$50 each way. The most logical and reasonable could transportation to and from the airport would be a POV or a rental car. All the details need to be worked out, but we believe that each family could pay a nominal amount to offset the cost of whatever meets our needs. Any excess money collected would be made available for the next year's reunion. We have received \$217 from the 2015 Tucson reunion.

As example of possibilities for those arriving on Wednesday, September 28, 2016, I have contacted *The New Dinner Theatre* (9229 Foster St, Overland Park, KS 66212) and have tentatively reserved 20 seats. The 2016 shows schedule comes out in early spring so we have time to ask if anyone is interested. The dinner and show is approximately \$50 per person. This past year's shows included:

- "Over the Moon" starring Marion Ross and Hal Linden;

The dinner is great and the shows are entertaining. I just wish we could bring Ron and Sadie's melodrama group here because it was one of the most entertaining nights I've ever experienced. Again, we will wait and see what is playing and then I'll get commitments from you. We can also just get together for dinner at a popular restaurant.

We had over 50 people attend in 2015 and are expecting more next year (we had several first-timers and we want to get the information out to as many as possible.) Please respond as soon as possible to above questions, but we'll need <u>tentative</u> attendance information no later than December 31, 2015, so we can start negotiating for the hotel and catering. Our goal is to keep all events affordable and will attempt to secure "group" rates whenever possible.
