Marriott Kansas City Airport, 775 Brasilia Avenue, KC, MO (I-435 and I-29 at the Kansas City Airport exit.) Rates: Single \$120.00; Double \$128.00. (Triples and Quads rates are also available) Taxes are 17.225% and License Fee of \$1.76 which brings the <u>total room rate per day</u> to Single \$142.43; Double \$151.81. This rate includes a daily full hot breakfast buffet serving all of the classic favorites and features a "cooked-to-order" station.

Hotel Shuttle Service: The Marriott Airport Shuttle departs the hotel beginning at 4:20 a.m. each day on a 20 minute cycle. Once your flight arrives at Kansas City International Airport, proceed to the baggage claim area and locate the Kansas City Airport Marriott on the Courtesy Board for pick up.

Banquet, Saturday, October 1. Get ready for a delicious Kansas City BBQ Dinner Buffet. Chef Gonzalez's BBQ Sauce won 1st place last year at the BBQ Competition!!! The total cost for the buffet (including tip, tax, etc) is \$47.42 for adults; Kids 4-12 are \$33.19; Children 0-3 are free.
